The Erasmus+ "CE-IP project" has completed its project cycle

After thirty-six months from its beginning (2020/2023), the CE-IP project has been brought to a positive and constructive end.

The six European partners (partnership of 6 partners coming from 5 countries) managed to conclude and to create positive impact towards the final beneficiaries of the project: (1) unemployed, self-employed and low-skilled workers coming from the productive sectors and (2) trainers approaching the continuing education systems providing courses for adults related to new employment opportunities.

Within these terms, the Erasmus+ project conceived 6 transnational meetings, it published a project management Manual, it promoted self-employment and it created new innovative and training solutions related to opportunities in the circular economy sector.
